- Attach a letter of acceptance from the university or college (for first-year students) **OR**
- Have a transcript sent directly from the school to the office of MFF (for students after the freshman year),
- Attach a brief summary of career goals (200-300 words),
- Attach a letter of recommendation from a teacher, member of the clergy, or an employer, and,
- Attach a description of community/volunteer service (if any).

Scholarships of \$500 to \$1,500 will be awarded at the discretion of the Michigan Forest Foundation's Board of Directors. Applicants must be Michigan residents or be attending Michigan schools. The curriculum of applicants should be in forestry or in other natural resources related to forestry.

Applicants may reapply for scholarships in subsequent years.
